Eucalyptus Arboretum Development

The eucalypt seedlings were potted up in late November and are continuing to grow, though they are growing slowly (must be the cool weather over summer). We had some losses with the wet weather in January, but they are enjoying the warmer drier weather that we are now getting.

Spraying of weeds is scheduled for Monday 24th January, and then the area can be ripped a few weeks later.

The Working Party meeting is on Thursday 27th January at 3pm in Meeting Room 1 at the Melton Community Hall.

If you know anyone who is willing to contribute please contact David Pye or John Bentley. The project requires site preparation involving activities such as marking out, ripping, building pathways plus getting associated materials and equipment.

We are currently preparing a Vision for Werribee Plains grant application of the order of \$120,000. This requires a co-contribution from FMBG. Some of this will be met by the work for the dole team, FMBG volunteer hours, MSC contributions Western Water and other contributions.


