Highlights are the natural features, the Dryland Eucalyptus Arboretum, WA and SA garden beds, Bushfoods Garden, Sensory Garden, Southern African, Mediterranean Garden, Californian, Central and South American bed and the indigenous plantings along Ryans Creek and beside the lake.
